Others welcome August for holidays and beach outings. But there are other interesting things about the golden-shiny month. Here are some August fun facts:

- 1. In the original Roman calendar, August was first called Sextilis, Latin for the sixth month. It was renamed in honour of Rome's first emperor, Caesar Augustus. Later, January and February were added to the calendar, making August the eighth month.
- 2. In a standard year, no other month starts on the same day as August. But in a leap year, August begins on the same day as February.
- 3. The first sandwich was made on August 6, 1762, when the Earl of Sandwich asked for a dish with meat between two pieces of bread. Legend has it that he ordered the meal in the middle of a gambling game and didn't want to interrupt it.
- 4. The birth flowers of August are the gladiolus, representing calmness, infatuation and integrity and the poppy, whose red tones signify peace, while the white and yellow express consolation and wealth and success respectively.

- 5. In the Caribbean, we start independence celebrations in August because Jamaica and Trinidad and Tobago got theirs in this month, 6th and 31st respectively.
- 6. Many powerful and popular Jamaicans were born in August including Marcus Garvey, Usain Bolt, Leon Bailey, Beanie Man, Spice, Lisa Hanna and Beres Hammond.
- 7. Whether it's a standard year or leap year, August always ends on the same day of the week as November.
- 8. If you were born in August, you reign under one of the two August stars: Leo and Virgo. Leos are considered as very proud people who display great leadership while Virgos are analytical, hardworking, kind, and loyal.
- 9. August is the only name of a month that features among the top 1,000 men's names. April and June are in the women's top 1,000.



### GUIDELINES FOR MAKING A REQUEST FOR IMPROVEMENTS, CHANGES OR ADDITIONS.

All requests to make changes, additions or alterations to or around the outside of your home must be submitted to the office for review.

This form and any accompanying paperwork must be turned into the office no less than 2 weeks prior to the start of work.

Requests must be on the front of this form which asks the following:

- 1. Written description of exactly what is to be done.
- 2. Drawing of proposed work needs to be attached.
- 3. Drawing should show position of home and any existing improvements on lot.
- 4. Description of materials to be used including style, color, etc.
- 5. Proposed construction timetable with proposed completion date.
- Improvements must not infringe, restrict, impede, hinder, obstruct or be in conflict with neighbor's property, common area and set-backs.
- 7. All improvements must be consistent in color and style of existing dwelling.
- 8. Homeowner is responsible for locating and marking underground utilities. Contact Sunshine Dig-Safe at phone number 811.
- 9. Homeowner is responsible for any damage to neighbor's property, common areas, and all underground utilities that have been located/marked or not located/marked.

These guidelines are not inclusive of homeowner responsibilities regarding maintaining or improving your home. Please refer to the Tarpon Shores Rules and Regulations for detailed information.

Project working hours: Monday – Saturday 8 A.M. to 6 P. M. NO SUNDAYS Plumbing working hours: Monday – Thursday 8 A.M. to 2 P.M.

Tarpon Shores is not required to provide City of Tarpon Springs permits. All work that requires a permit (City or County) is the full responsibility of the homeowner and a copy of the permit must be turned into the office.

The jobsite must be kept clean and orderly. All work materials must be removed immediately following completion of the job.

### ADDENDUM FOR REQUEST FOR IMPROVEMENTS, CHANGES OR ADDITIONS

### Special conditions:

Use caution digging. Many unmarked utility lines are underground such as potable water, irrigation water, electric lines, cable TV lines, etc. These utility lines/pipes are most likely not buried very deep.

Please prepare the area by delicately digging/trenching and identifying where the lines are located prior to the commencement of the construction work. Move any lines that have to be relocated.

Kindly contact the office prior to digging so we can attempt to give you a general idea where the lines are buried. We do not have plans/blueprints to some of the buried utility lines so the park will not be responsible for accurately identifying these lines.

Contact Sunshine Dig Safe at telephone number 811.

Please schedule all work to be done Monday – Thursday. If you break a main line or individual line we may have to contact a plumber and this can get costly if it is after hours. The homeowner who breaks a line is responsible for all payments associated with its repairs.
