Excerpt from Rules and Regulations concerning holiday decorations:

"Seasonal holiday decorations, including decorative lights and flags, may only be displayed from October 1 to January 15 of the next year. Other holiday decorations, including decorative lights and flags, may be displayed seven (7) days before and must be removed seven (7) days after the specific holiday. Notwithstanding anything above, no holiday decorations shall exceed fifteen (15) days unless they fall within the dates for seasonal decorations set

forth in the first sentence of this provision. The Association reserves the right to require the removal of any offensive or nuisance lights or decoration."

November Fun Facts THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

November's name comes from the Latin word for "nine," reflecting its original place in the Roman calendar before January and February were added. The month's birthstone is the topaz or citrine, and its birth flower is the chrysanthemum. Key historical events include the signing of the Mayflower Compact (1620) and the end of World War I (1918), now observed as Veterans Day. It's also a time for celebrations like Thanksgiving and awareness campaigns such as Movember, which encourages growing mustaches to support men's health.

WHAT WAS INVENTED IN NOVEMBER?

November has been a historically significant month for invention and scientific discovery, featuring breakthroughs like the phonograph (1877), the first transistor (1947), the first barbed wire patent (1874), and the first traffic signal (1923), among others. Early November also saw key scientific milestones, including the presentation of the theory of general relativity (1915) and the discovery of X-rays (1895).



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Owner/Community Portal (Vantaca)



GUIDELINES FOR MAKING A REQUEST FOR IMPROVEMENTS. **CHANGES OR ADDITIONS.**

All requests to make changes, additions or alterations to or around the outside of your home must be submitted to the office for review.

This form and any accompanying paperwork must be turned into the office no less than 2 weeks prior to the start of work.

Requests must be on the front of this form which asks the following:

- 1. Written description of exactly what is to be done.
- 2. Drawing of proposed work needs to be attached.
- 3. Drawing should show position of home and any existing improvements on lot.
- Description of materials to be used including style, color, etc.
- Proposed construction timetable with proposed completion date.
- 6. Improvements must not infringe, restrict, impede, hinder, obstruct or be in conflict with neighbor's property, common area and set-backs.
- 7. All improvements must be consistent in color and style of existing dwelling.
- 8. Homeowner is responsible for locating and marking underground utilities. Contact Sunshine Dig-Safe at phone number 811.
- 9. Homeowner is responsible for any damage to neighbor's property, common areas, and all underground utilities that have been located/marked or not located/marked.

These guidelines are not inclusive of homeowner responsibilities regarding maintaining or mproving your home. Please refer to the Tarpon Shores Rules and Regulations for detailed nformation.

Project working hours: Monday - Saturday 8 A.M. to 6 P. M. NO SUNDAYS Plumbing working hours: Monday - Thursday 8 A.M. to 2 P.M.

Tarpon Shores is not required to provide City of Tarpon Springs permits. All work that requires permit (City or County) is the full responsibility of the homeowner and a copy of the permit nust be turned into the office.


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
