It's that time again. We are in the process of working on the 2027 Budget. We will be having a budget workshop in mid-August for the Board to review the worksheets and determine our path going forward.

Unfortunately, the Phase III water restrictions have been extended until October. Although we have been receiving some rain it isn't enough to bolster the health of the grass and shrubs throughout the park.

EXCERPT FROM RULES AND REGULATIONS

PARAGRAPH 3 THE HOMESITE

(a) Lessees are responsible for the overall appearance of the site. It shall be kept neat, orderly, clean and free of litter. Only furniture specifically designed for outside use is allowed outside of the home. The Association will be responsible for making periodic inspections and informing Lessees of any deficiencies. Failure to remedy such deficiencies will allow the Association the right to correct or bring in outside contractors with the cost passed on to the Lessees or to take action under the TSROA Bylaws, Article 12.1.

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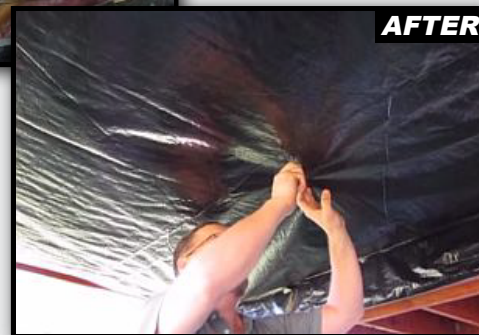

As we ride through the community, we continue to notice many overgrown plants, trees, and shrubs in backyards. Remember, your backyard is visible to your neighbors, even if it can't be seen from the street.

Please take time to properly dispose of unwanted flower pots, dead plants, bricks, and other debris. Keeping your property neat helps maintain the beauty of our entire community.

Some trees and bushes have become so overgrown that they make it difficult to mow and weed-whack around them. A little trimming goes a long way in keeping our park looking its best.

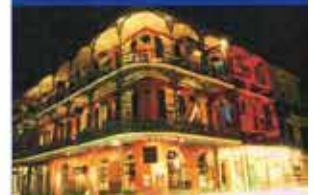

Sunset Beach



For those of you who like to visit Sunset Beach, the City of Tarpon Springs is establishing guidelines affecting parking that will go into effect on August 1, 2026. Beginning August 1, there will be a \$5.00 per day charge to park at the beach. Park Mobile will be there so you can use your app to pay.

If you are a resident of Tarpon Springs, you can get a free parking pass from the City by showing the registration for your vehicle and a Tarpon Springs ID reflecting your Tarpon Springs address. Non-Residents such as snowbirds or Canadians will have to show your photo ID, your car registration, and either a utility bill or a tax bill to receive the free parking pass. If you are a renter, you will be required to show your rental agreement, your ID and your car registration. For the first few weeks the City will issue warnings to vehicles that do not display the parking pass. After that the City will issue a \$25.00 fine.

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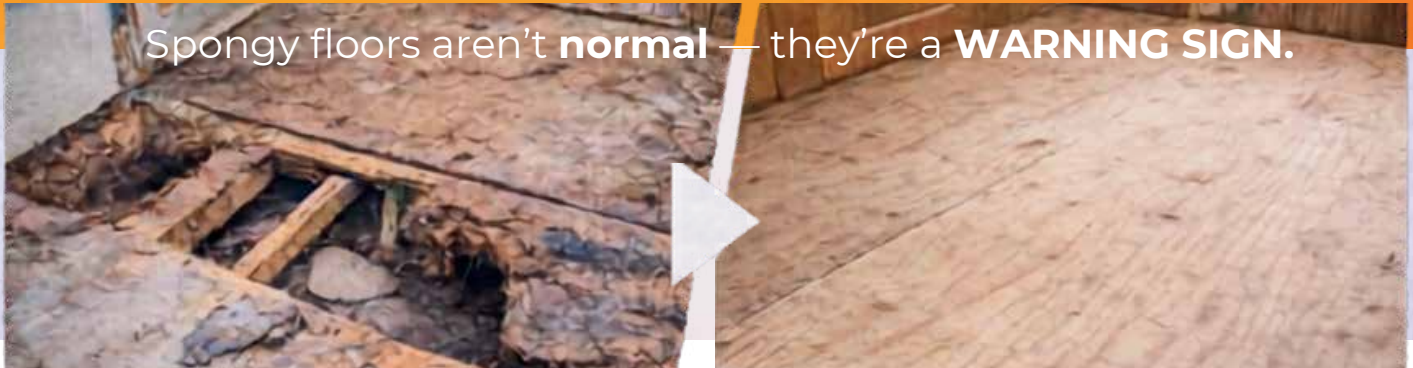
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August 7th, National Purple Heart Day: *Honoring America's Wounded and Brave*



Every year on August 7, Americans observe National Purple Heart Day, a time to recognize the extraordinary courage and sacrifice of members of the U.S. Armed Forces who have been wounded or killed while serving their country. Unlike many military awards that recognize acts of heroism or exceptional service, the Purple Heart stands apart because it is awarded to those who have paid a physical price in the defense of the nation. National Purple Heart Day serves as an important reminder of the personal sacrifices behind the freedoms Americans enjoy today.

The history of the Purple Heart dates back to the Revolutionary War. On August 7, 1782, General George Washington created the Badge of Military Merit, making it the first military decoration established by the newly formed United States. Washington wanted to recognize enlisted soldiers for "singularly meritorious action," a significant departure from the European tradition of honoring only officers and nobility.

The original badge was a simple heart-shaped piece of purple cloth edged with silver. Only three soldiers are known to have received the Badge of Military Merit during the Revolutionary War: Sergeant Elijah Churchill, Sergeant William Brown, and Sergeant Daniel Bissell. After the war, however, the award gradually fell into disuse and was eventually forgotten for more than a century.

The modern Purple Heart was revived in 1932 to commemorate the 200th anniversary of George Washington's birth. The redesigned medal retained the heart shape and purple color of the original badge while featuring a profile of Washington. Initially, the award recognized military personnel who had been wounded in combat or who had demonstrated exceptional military merit. Over time, the criteria evolved, and today the Purple Heart is awarded exclusively to members of the U.S. military who are wounded or killed as a direct result of enemy action.

National Purple Heart Day is also observed on August 7, honoring the anniversary of Washington's creation of the original Badge of Military Merit. Communities across the country commemorate the day with ceremonies, flag-raising events, veterans' gatherings, educational programs, and moments of

remembrance. Many cities have even earned the designation of "Purple Heart City," demonstrating their commitment to honoring combat-wounded veterans.

One interesting chapter in the Purple Heart's history involves its first modern recipient. The distinction belongs to Douglas MacArthur, who received Purple Heart Number One on February 22, 1932. MacArthur, then serving as the Army Chief of Staff, had been wounded while leading troops during the Veracruz Expedition in 1914. Although he had never received formal recognition for those combat wounds, the newly reinstated Purple Heart made him eligible. As the driving force behind reviving the medal, MacArthur was awarded the first Purple Heart of the modern era in recognition of the wounds he sustained while serving his country.

Since its reestablishment, nearly two million Purple Hearts have been awarded to American service members from conflicts including World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Persian Gulf War, and the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. Each medal represents a deeply personal story of courage, sacrifice, and resilience.

The Purple Heart is unique because it is not earned through recommendation or competition. Instead, it is bestowed upon those whose injuries or deaths resulted directly from enemy action. For many recipients, the medal symbolizes not only their own sacrifice but also the dedication of the fellow service members who stood beside them during some of the nation's most challenging moments.

National Purple Heart Day offers Americans an opportunity to pause and reflect on the tremendous cost of freedom. By honoring Purple Heart recipients, we acknowledge the bravery of those who endured wounds in service to their country and express gratitude for their willingness to place themselves in harm's way. Their sacrifices remind us that liberty is preserved through the courage and commitment of generations of men and women who answered the call to serve.

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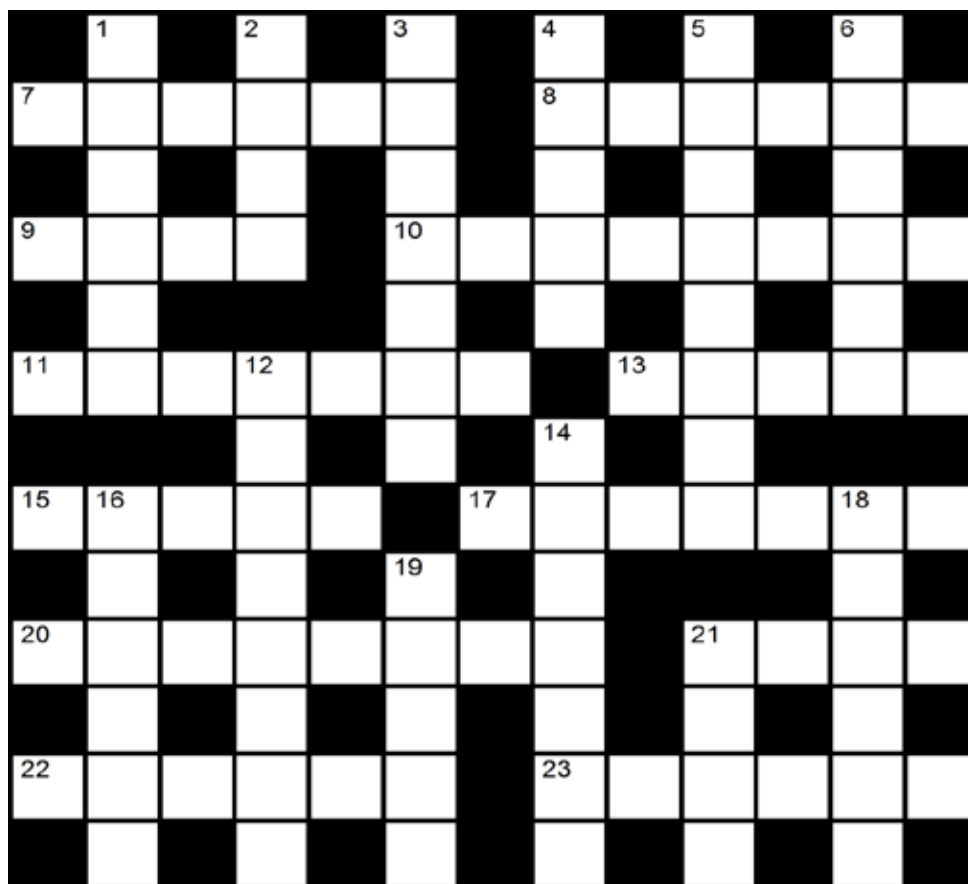


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CROSSWORD

GUIDELINES FOR MAKING A REQUEST FOR IMPROVEMENTS, CHANGES OR ADDITIONS.

All requests to make changes, additions or alterations to or around the outside of your home must be submitted to the office for review.

This form and any accompanying paperwork must be turned into the office no less than 2 weeks prior to the start of work.

Requests must be on the front of this form which asks the following:

1. Written description of exactly what is to be done.
2. Drawing of proposed work needs to be attached.
3. Drawing should show position of home and any existing improvements on lot.
4. Description of materials to be used including style, color, etc.
5. Proposed construction timetable with proposed completion date.
6. Improvements must not infringe, restrict, impede, hinder, obstruct or be in conflict with neighbor's property, common area and set-backs.
7. All improvements must be consistent in color and style of existing dwelling.
8. Homeowner is responsible for locating and marking underground utilities. Contact Sunshine Dig-Safe at phone number 811.
9. Homeowner is responsible for any damage to neighbor's property, common areas, and all underground utilities that have been located/marked or not located/marked.

These guidelines are not inclusive of homeowner responsibilities regarding maintaining or improving your home. Please refer to the Tarpon Shores Rules and Regulations for detailed information.

Project working hours: Monday – Saturday 8 A.M. to 6 P. M. NO SUNDAYS

Plumbing working hours: Monday – Thursday 8 A.M. to 2 P.M.

Tarpon Shores is not required to provide City of Tarpon Springs permits. All work that requires a permit (City or County) is the full responsibility of the homeowner and a copy of the permit must be turned into the office.

The jobsite must be kept clean and orderly. All work materials must be removed immediately following completion of the job.
