## Manager's Corner – March 2026

The annual members meeting of the Association was held on Thursday, January 15. There were 166 voting members represented with a combination of those attending the meeting and those that returned their proxy. At that time the election of directors was conducted. Deborah (Debbie) Lasater and Charles (Charlie) Anderson were elected for a three-year term.

When you are going away for extended periods of time or for the summer months, be sure to complete the Going Away Form. This form is important in the event the office needs to contact you about a situation that may require immediate attention. Be sure to list who will be responsible for looking after your lot during that time (i.e. weeding, irrigation).



### Excerpt from Rules and Regulations:

**“8. VEHICLES** – (a) A limit of two licensed vehicles per home is allowed, examples include two (2) automobiles, one (1) automobile and one (1) van or pickup truck or motorcycle. Any vehicle parked at the home must have a current valid license plate tag and be operable. Vehicles shall be parked on the street so as to not impede the safe passage of other vehicles. Lessees shall park their vehicles only in driveways or carports and not extend on to the sidewalk or on any lawn in the Community. For reasons of safety, visitors shall not park in the streets when parking space is available in the driveway. Automobile repairs, other than emergency procedures such as flat tires, are not permitted in the Community. Parking on sidewalks, throughout the Community is prohibited. There will be no on-street parking between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M. Any parking of any vehicle's contrary to the above rules will be subject to towing by a company under contract with the Association without further notice”.

## Fun Facts About March

The 2026 Farmers' Almanac and Old Farmers Almanac predict a warmer-than-normal spring for much of the U.S., though early March may feature lingering cold, especially in the North Central regions. The Northeast can expect a "cool, soggy" start, while the South faces a wet spring, with March 2-4 being ideal for early planting.

March may be named after the Roman god of war but in reality it's one of the happiest months on the calendar. Flowers are budding, chocolate is on sale, and its major holiday is just one giant party, with no gifts and minimal stress. Plus, it even turns math into a pie-eating celebration! But that's just the beginning of all the reasons to love March.

### 1. March was once considered the first month of the year

Welcome to the third month of the year—or if you were born before 150 B.C., the first! According to the oldest Roman calendars, one year was 10 months long, beginning in March and ending in December. It may sound crazy, but you can still see traces of this old system in our modern calendar: Because December was the 10th month, it was named for the number 10 in Latin (decem), just like September was named for seven (septem). January and February were the exceptions: They were just two nameless months called "winter," proving that winter is literally so awful, it doesn't even deserve a spot on the calendar.

For civilians, the month of March is known for one thing above all others: brackets. March Madness, as the NCAA calls it, runs from March 18 to April 7 this year. But despite being an exciting month for college-hoops fans, March is not the best for U.S. employers. According to the global outplacement firm Challenger, Gray & Christmas, productivity decreases during March Madness, with U.S. employers losing around \$13.3 billion in productivity during the tournament.

4. Description of materials to be used including style, color, etc.
5. Proposed construction timetable with proposed completion date.
6. Improvements must not infringe, restrict, impede, hinder, obstruct or be in conflict with neighbor's property, common area and set-backs.
7. All improvements must be consistent in color and style of existing dwelling.
8. Homeowner is responsible for locating and marking underground utilities. Contact Sunshine Dig-Safe at phone number 811.
9. Homeowner is responsible for any damage to neighbor's property, common areas, and all underground utilities that have been located/marked or not located/marked.

These guidelines are not inclusive of homeowner responsibilities regarding maintaining or improving your home. Please refer to the Tarpon Shores Rules and Regulations for detailed information.


